### **Introduction:**

The **UGC-Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Centre (formerly known as UGC-HRDC)**, Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Hyderabad, was established in the year 2000 and sponsored by University Grants Commission, New Delhi. The UGC MMTC organizes Orientation Programmes, Faculty Induction Programmes, Refresher Courses, Short Term Courses, NEP Orientation & Sensitization Programme and Workshops on thrust areas for in-service teachers and also for newly appointed teaching faculty on a regular basis, to update the knowledge and skills in their respective fields.

The **Faculty Induction Programme** will orient the faculty of Universities and Colleges on various generic aspects of teaching-learning, instructional methodologies, assessment and evaluation techniques, ICT enabled teaching learning, and equip them with knowledge of University rules and regulations, basics of governance and administration.

### **Rationale of Faculty Induction Programme:**

- To sensitize and motivate the faculty to adopt learner centered approaches, ICT integrated learning and new pedagogic approaches to teaching-learning, assessment tools in higher education.
- Implement curriculum reforms in the context of inter disciplinarily, multi-disciplinarily and applied approaches to knowledge.
- Adopt flexible evaluation processes which are more specific to evaluate multiple skills and competencies of students.
- Promote four possible types of faculty development: personal (inter personal skills, career development, and life planning issues); instructional (course design and development, instructional technology); organizational (ways to improve the institutional environment to better support teaching); and professional (ways to support faculty members so that they fulfill their multiple roles of teaching, research and service).
- To promote academic excellence, teaching innovation, research capabilities and leadership skills.
- To promote the professional capability and performance of teachers to deliver effective and quality learning.

During the current academic year 2024-2025, the **Faculty Induction Programme-17** is proposed to be organized during **18-11-2024 to 16-12-2024**, through **ONLINE mode**. The number of participants is limited to a maximum of 80, and the selection will be based on the priority of 'first - come-first-serve'.
