Introduction:

The UGC-Human Resource Development Centre (formerly known as UGC-Academic Staff College), Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Hyderabad, was established in the year 2000 and sponsored by University Grants Commission, New Delhi. The UGC HRDC organizes Orientation Programmes, Faculty Induction Programmes, Refresher Courses, Short Term Courses and Workshops on thrust areas for in-service teachers and also for newly appointed teaching faculty on a regular basis, to update the knowledge and skills in their respective fields.

- Implement curriculum reforms in the context of interdisciplinarity, multi-disciplinarity and applied approaches to knowledge.
- Adopt flexible evaluation processes which are more specific to evaluate multiple skills and competencies of students.
- Promote four possible types of faculty development: personal (interpersonal skills, career development, and life planning issues); instructional (course design and development, instructional technology); organisational (ways to improve the institutional environment to better support teaching); and professional (ways to support faculty members so that they fulfill their multiple roles of teaching, research and service).
- To promote academic excellence, teaching innovation, research capabilities and leadership skills.
- To promote the professional capability and performance of teachers to deliver effective and quality learning.

During the current academic year 2020-2021, the Faculty Induction Programme-I is proposed to be organised during 03-08-2020 to 10-09-2020, through ONLINE mode. The number of participants is limited to a maximum of 40, and the selection will be based on the priority of 'first - come-first-serve'.

- Faculty & Academic Staff of Central and State Universities, Centrally Funded Technical Institutions, Degree and PG Degree Colleges.
- Faculty from all branches of Engineering, Sciences, Arts, Commerce & Management.




