### **Introduction:**

The **UGC-Human Resource Development Centre (formerly known as UGC-Academic Staff College)**, Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Hyderabad, was established in the year 2000 and sponsored by University Grants Commission, New Delhi. - Implement curriculum reforms in the context of interdisciplinarity, multi-disciplinarity and applied approaches to knowledge.
- Adopt flexible evaluation processes which are more specific to evaluate multiple skills and competencies of students.
- Promote four possible types of faculty development: personal (interpersonal skills, career development, and life planning issues); instructional (course design and development, instructional technology); organisational (ways to improve the institutional environment to better support teaching); and professional (ways to support faculty members so that they fulfill their multiple roles of teaching, research and service).
- To promote academic excellence, teaching innovation, research capabilities and leadership skills.
- To promote the professional capability and performance of teachers to deliver effective and quality learning.

During the current academic year 2021-2022, the **Faculty Induction Programme-8** is proposed to be organised during **24-01-2022 to 28-02-2022**, through **ONLINE mode**. The number of participants is limited to a maximum of 40, and the selection will be based on the priority of 'first - come-first-serve'.
