The details are as follows:

- To create high quality human resources and to adopt innovative approaches in Higher Education, the HRDC of JNTUH has been organizing several programs viz. Orientation Programmes, Refresher Courses, Short Term Courses, Workshops, Faculty Development Programmes for the members of the Faculty.
- The HRDC has received approval for 32 courses from University Grants Commission for the year 2019-20, out of which 26 courses have been conducted successfully from May – March 2020.
- In the academic year 2019-20, JNTUH entered into an MoU with All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) for conducting the Short Term Training Programmes for the Faculty of AICTE approved Institutions affiliated to JNTUH. The AICTE has sanctioned 10 Programmes for this academic year and 9 programmes were conducted till date through HRDC.
- The HRDC also conducted 4 National Workshops under Technical Education Quality Improvement Program (TEQIP-III) of JNTUH.
- A total number of 1429 members of faculty from various departments of Engineering, Sciences, Arts, Commerce and Management of various Engineering and Degree Colleges, all over the Country have been trained during this Academic Year till date.
- The HRDC has conducted a one-day Principals Meet on the theme “Challenges of Academic Administration in 21st Century” on 27-09-2019 and a three-day Short Term Course on “Technology Enhanced Learning for Academic Administrators – Head of the Departments” from 18 – 20, November 2019.
- Apart from this the HRDC also conducted a three-day short term course on “Skill Enhancement for Non-teaching Staff” from 02-04, December 2019, for the administrative officers and staff of the University.
- Computer Lab was upgraded with networking facility for 30 systems to provide hands-on sessions to the participants to enhance the practical knowledge.
- Online system was initiated and incorporated for participant registrations, payment of registration fee and to take feedback about the sessions delivered from the academic



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
